

Hapton Juniors Football Club Coaches Code of Conduct

By registering to coach any Hapton Juniors FC team, you agree to the rules & guidelines set out in this document.

ON AND OFF THE FIELD, I WILL:

- Use my position to set a positive example for the young people I am responsible for
- Show respect to others involved in the game including match officials, opposition players, coaches, managers, officials and spectators
- Adhere to the laws and spirit of the game
- · Promote Fair Play and high standards of behaviour
- · Respect the match official's decision
- Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- · Be gracious in victory and defeat.
- * Ensure that all matchday & training requirements are met, including correct use of respect barriers,
- * Ensure that all equipment I use will be looked after and replaced in the appropriate way.
- * Complete all Administration within the given time frame including but not limited to Matchday reports, and be responsible for any fines incurred from the League or LFA for non-completion of administration
- * Uphold & promote the values of Hapton Juniors Football club at all times, ENJOY ENCOURAGE & INSPIRE

WHEN WORKING WITH PLAYERS, I WILL:

- Place the well-being, safety and enjoyment of each player above everything, including winning
- · Never engage in or tolerate any form of bullying
- Encourage each player to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- Ensure all activities I organise are appropriate for the players' ability level, age and maturity
- Co-operate fully with others in football (e.g. officials, doctors, physiotherapists, welfare officers) for each player's best interest
- * Report any Safeguarding or Welfare concerns to the relevant club officials immediately
- * Ensure all my required CPD & compliance is kept up to date
- * Enjoy what I do

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA:

I MAY BE:

- Required to meet with the club, league or County Welfare Officer
- Suspended by the club from attending matches
- Suspended or fined by the County FA
- Required to leave or be sacked by the club. IN ADDITION:
- My FA Coaching Licence may be withdrawn.
