By Registering your child with Hapton JFC, you and guardians of your child(ren) agree to adhere to the rules & guidelines outlined in this document. Hapton JFC is a safe & enjoyable environment for all children to play football.

Remember, the game is for them not us.

Whilst registered with the club You will:

- Never engage in or tolerate, offensive, abusive language or behaviour
- Stay behind the designated Respect area where provided
- Refrain from 'coaching' your child or players from the side-line (This is the coaches' job)
- Treat Referees & Officials with respect & courtesy
- Treat all venues you visit with respect & consideration including adhering to club requests around parking or club guidelines
- Ensure that your child(ren) is accompanied by an appropriate adult at all training sessions & matches
- Accept responsibility for any poor behaviour shown by your child(ren)
- Return any kit or team wear that has been provided by the club should you leave Hapton JFC
- Pay monthly subs on time on 1st of each month. Unless agreed with club prior, any club member falling 2 months behind with subs, will have their reg suspended until brought FULLY up to date.
- Offer encouragement, support & celebrate success
- Enjoy watching your child & team take part in training, matches & tournaments

You understand that if you do not follow this Code of Conduct, you may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Obliged to undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have my membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents and/or issued a fine
